# OUR ACHIEVEMENTS

## EXPANSION OF FAMILY STRENGTHENING METHODOLOGY

In India, we partnered with 10 states, supported policy initiatives in several states, and empowered child protection leaders, strengthening family-based care nationwide. Together, we're making a lasting impact. We have officially expanded our prevention work to the US and Africa! ThriveWell's family-strengthening capability is now used by several partner organizations in Texas, enhancing the holistic support they provide to families. In addition, we have expanded our Thrive Scale methodology into East Africa, implementing our new ThriveWell application in Uganda.

## BROADENING OUR IMPACT IN THE US

We have continued to increase our reach in the US foster care system, impacting more children and families than ever. This year, we have significantly expanded our operations, working in the majority of regions in Texas, and started working in Oklahoma and Indiana. Our ThriveWell app helps provide essential support to caseworkers and foster families to ensure that children and families receive the comprehensive care they need.

# OUR ACHIEVEMENTS

## INCREASING SKILLS OF SOCIAL WORKERS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD

In India, we launched the Center for Excellence Care Collective, which advances family strengthening and family-based alternative care. Through powerful partnerships with five other NGOs, we're creating sustainable change and impact in multiple states across India. In addition to our work in India, we have expanded our training efforts to the US and Africa for the first time, offering guidance on best practices in child and family strengthening. The training sessions are focused on effectively using the Thrive Scale to better care for children and building trusting relationships with families.

## EMPOWERING THOSE WITH LIVED EXPERIENCE AND YOUTH

We continue to support and mentor our Social Impact Summit attendees by providing one-on-one training in strategic planning, finance, marketing, and impact measurement as they drive change through their NGOs. In India, we have expanded our Youth Ambassador program, offering hands-on mentorship and support, as well as active participation in BICON, webinars, and program design.

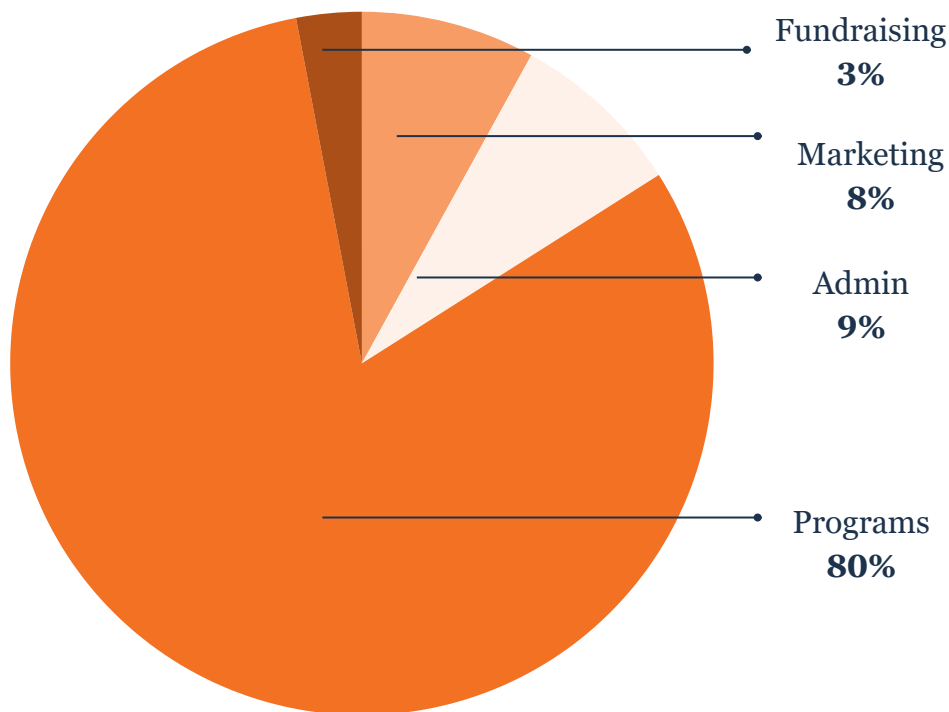

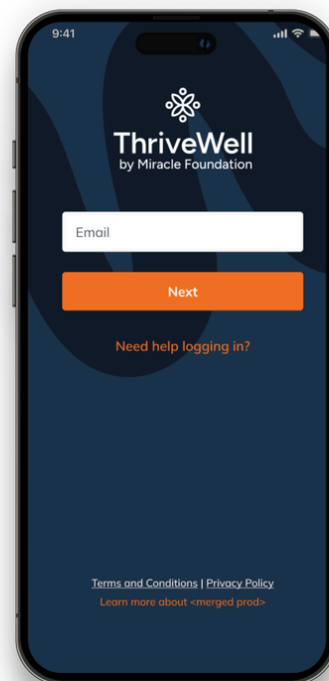
